Parent Appeal of Decision

Parents who wish to appeal the decision of the identification screening committee should contact the coordinator/specialist of gifted education for a conference. The coordinator/specialist will review all placement criteria with the parent. If no resolution can be reached, the district procedure for appeals will be followed. The appeal will be taken back to the placement committee, which is chaired by the gifted and talented coordinator, and consists of classroom teachers, counselor, and principal from the particular campus involved. The review of the appeal and decision made at the time are final.

In the event of non-placement, the principal and the coordinator/specialist of the gifted program may discuss the student's academic profile with the parent. Suggestions for home and school strategies to help the student progress will be made, based on the data collected by the coordinator and the identification screening committee.
